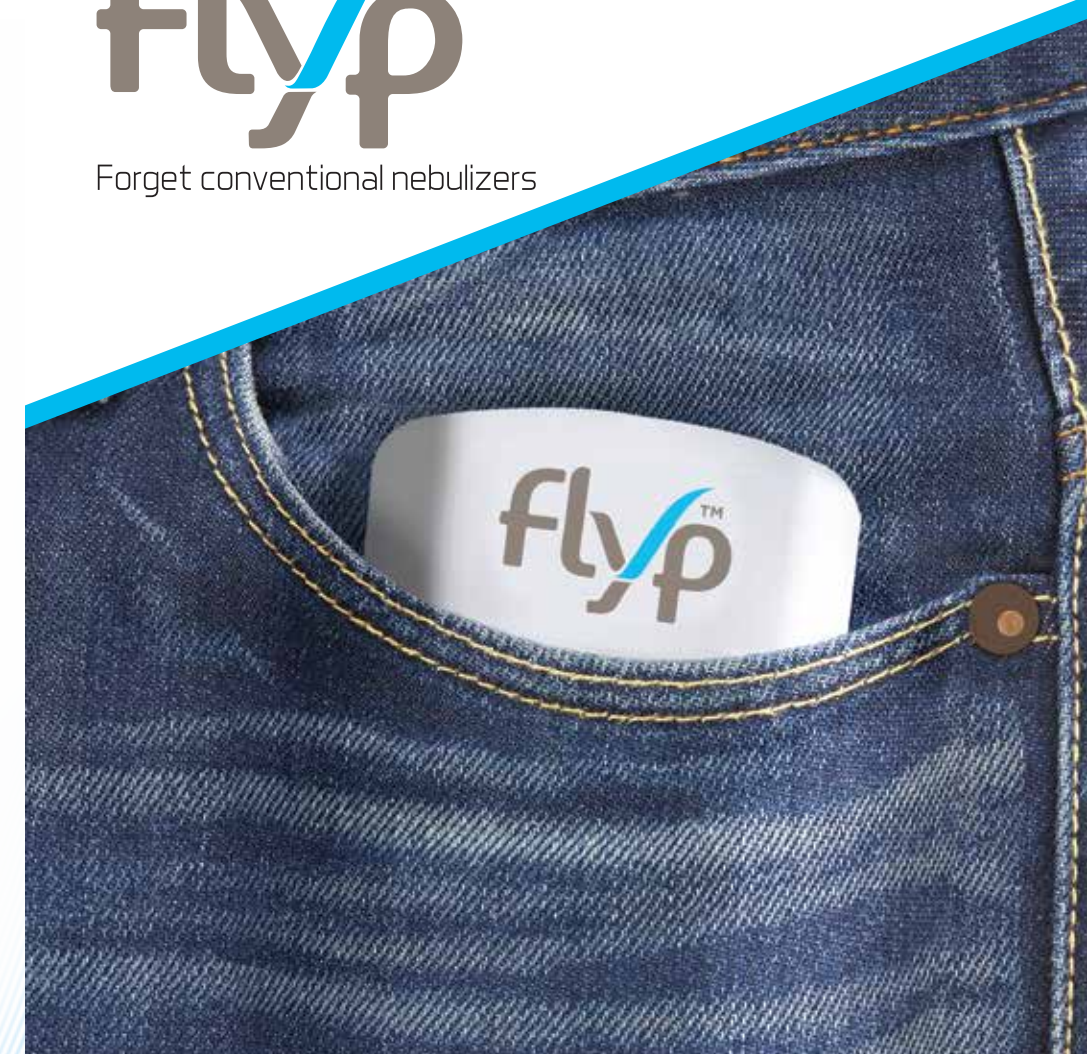

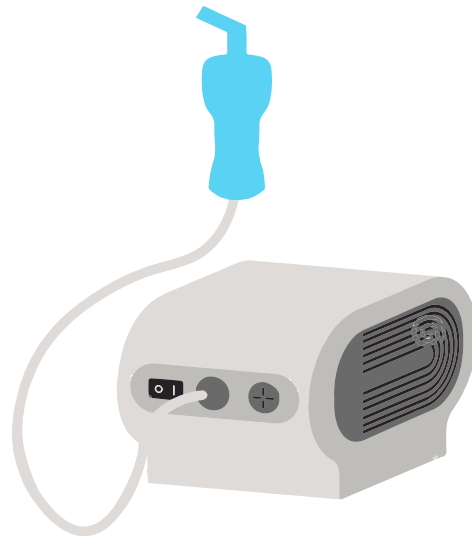

## The problem with other nebulizers

### Too large and heavy

Try putting one in your pocket. So-called 'portable' nebulizers aren't so portable.



### Too slow

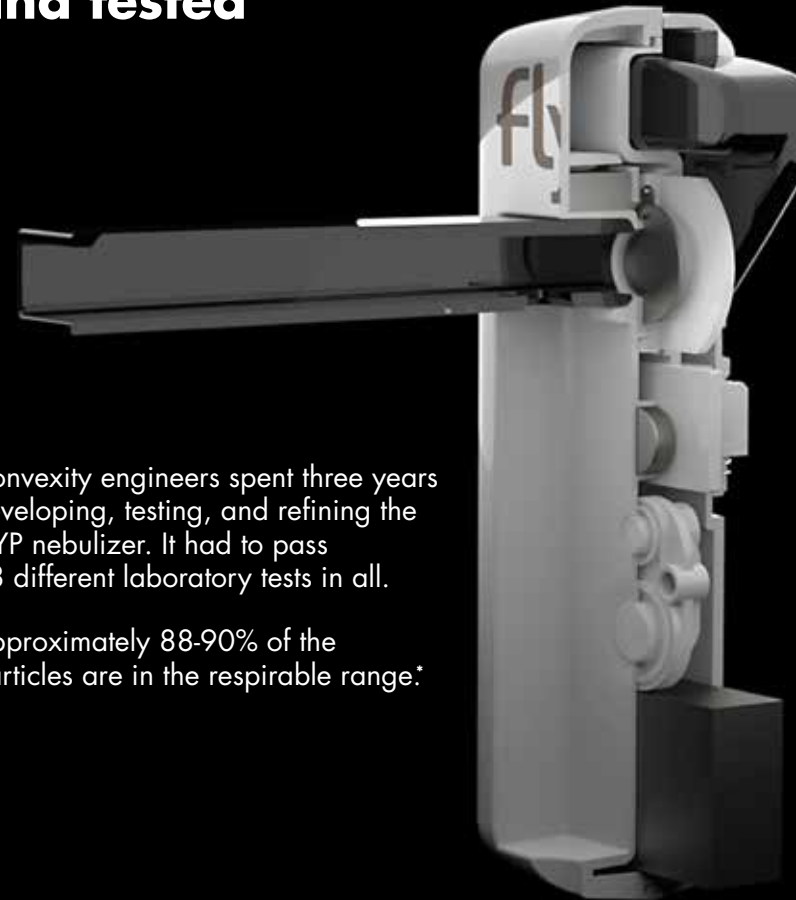
Other nebulizers take up to 15-20 minutes to dispense 3ml of medication.

### Expensive to operate

Batteries typically need to be replaced every 8 days if used 3 times per day, adding \$150 or more to cost over 3 years.



## Convexity engineered and tested



Convexity engineers spent three years developing, testing, and refining the FLYP nebulizer. It had to pass 18 different laboratory tests in all.

Approximately 88-90% of the particles are in the respirable range.\*

## HypersoniQ engineering

It starts with a precision-engineered disk with 1,000 holes so small that they are invisible to the naked eye.

The disk is made to vibrate at an ultrasonic speed that is 2,000 times faster than a hummingbird's wings. We call it our HypersoniQ technology.



As medication passes through the disk's holes, it is broken up into an aerosol that can be inhaled for delivery to your lungs.
