


# DC Power Adapter User Guide



### DESCRIPTION

The DC Power Adapter and accessories allow you to operate many Respironics BiPAP systems from a 12 VDC power source. Using the included Automobile Cigarette Lighter Adapter (or "Auto Adapter"), the Power Adapter plugs into a standard vehicle cigarette lighter socket. Using the included Battery Adapter Cable, it can be connected directly to a free-standing 12 VDC battery.



### **G**ENERAL **O**PERATING **I**NFORMATION

### Low Battery:

When operating a BiPAP\* Harmony\*, Synchrony\*, or BiPAP S/T unit, the therapy device will sound an alarm when the battery requires recharging. You should stop using your therapy device with the battery immediately because the DC Power Adapter will automatically shut down shortly after the alarm sounds.

When operating a BiPAP Pro 2 or BiPAP Plus unit, the DC Power Adapter will shut down when the battery voltage is outside of the input voltage range (see Specifications later in this manual). Stop using your therapy device with the battery when this occurs.

If the DC Power Adapter shuts down when the battery is fully charged, follow the steps for remedying lack of output power in the Troubleshooting Guide later in this manual. The adapter will shut down when it is overloaded or if there is an excessive voltage drop between it and the battery.

### Placement of Power Adapter:

Do not operate the DC Power Adapter on or near a heating vent or piece of equipment that is generating heat above room temperature or in direct sunlight.

### Dispersion of Heat:

The DC Power Adapter will get warm during normal operation. The amount of heat generated will vary with the therapy device being operated. In order for proper heat dispersion to occur, do not place items on or over the DC Power Adapter during operation. Make sure that air is allowed to circulate freely around the adapter.

### **WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS**

Refer to the BiPAP S/T, BiPAP Harmony, Synchrony, and the BiPAP Pro 2/Plus User Manuals for a complete list of warnings and cautions associated with the use of this accessory with these therapy devices.

#### WARNINGS

- Serious Shock Hazard. Do not open the DC Power Adapter. There are no user serviceable parts inside the adapter. Refer all servicing to your medical equipment supplier or Respironics.
- When using the Battery Adapter Cable, the black clamp must always be connected to the negative terminal of the battery, and the red clamp must always be connected to the positive terminal.
- When connecting the Battery Adapter Cable to a battery, DO NOT allow loosefitting metal jewelry to touch the battery posts.
- Always disconnect the cables from the power source and the therapy device before moving the equipment.
- When operating with the Auto Adapter, DO NOT operate while the vehicle is running.
- · Not for use in a mobile environment.

#### **C**AUTIONS

- The DC Power Adapter and accessories are designed for use with the Respironics' products listed later in this document. The power adapter should not be used for any other purposes.
- Only Respironics' connecting cables should be used. Use of any other cable types may cause damage to the adapter and the therapy device.
- The DC Power Adapter is intended for use on 12 V "positive hot" electrical systems. These systems may also be referred to as "negative ground" systems. If you are unsure about your electrical system's polarity, check with the vehicle's manufacturer.
- Do not connect the DC Power Adapter to household or recreational vehicle AC distribution wiring. Using the adapter on AC distribution wiring may cause damage to the AC power source, the adapter, and the therapy device.
- Respironics recommends that a fully-charged 12 VDC 100 amp-hour, deep cycle marine-type battery be used. Use of a battery rated less than 100 amp-hours may reduce the length of operation. Each battery type has its own operating and recharging characteristics. You should be familiar with the requirements of the battery type that you are using.
- DO NOT leave the Auto Adapter plugged into your vehicle when the Power Adapter is not in use.

## For Operation from a Free-standing 12 VDC Battery

Items Required: Respironics Therapy Device

12 VDC Battery DC Power Adapter Battery Adapter Cable

**NOTE**: The battery should be fully charged before use.

Step 1 Turn OFF the therapy device.

Step 2 Plug the DC Power Adapter's input cable into the Battery Adapter Cable.

Step 3 Connect the Battery Adapter Cable clamps to a free-standing 12 VDC battery as follows (see illustration):


Red Clamp - Positive Post (+)

Black Clamp - Negative Post (-)

Step 4 Plug the DC Power Adapter's output cable into one of the power receptacles on the rear of the Respironics device.

Step 5 Turn the therapy device on, and verify proper operation.

**NOTE**: Actual power consumption will vary according to prescription pressures and breathing patterns. The lower the prescription, the less power required.




### FOR OPERATION FROM A PORTABLE BATTERY PACK

Items Required: Respironics Therapy Device

Portable Battery Pack
DC Power Adapter
Cigarette Lighter Adapter

- Step 1 Turn OFF the therapy device.
- Step 2 Connect the input cable end of the DC Power Adapter to the Cigarette Lighter Adapter.
- Step 3 Plug the Cigarette Lighter Adapter into the socket of the portable battery pack.
- Step 4 Plug the DC Power Adapter's output cable into one of the power receptacles on the rear of the Respironics device.
- Step 5 Turn the therapy device on, and verify proper operation.




### For Operation from a Vehicle Cigarette Lighter Connection

Items Required: Respironics Therapy Device

DC Power Adapter Cigarette Lighter Adapter

- Step 1 Turn OFF the therapy device.
- Step 2 Connect the Cigarette Lighter Adapter to the input cable end of the Power Adapter.
- Step 3 Remove the cigarette lighter from its socket.
- Step 4 Plug the Cigarette Lighter Adapter into the cigarette lighter socket.
- Step 5 Plug the DC Power Adapter's output cable into one of the power receptacles on the rear of the Respironics device.
- Step 6 Turn the therapy device on, and verify proper operation.

**CAUTION:** Use of this system with an automotive battery may drain the battery. Monitor operation to ensure there is sufficient power remaining to start the vehicle.



### **S**PECIFICATIONS

Voltage In: 10.5 - 16.7 VDC (The DC Power Adapter shuts down when the input voltage is outside of this range.)

Voltage Out: 20.0 ±2.0 VDC

Maximum Continuous DC Output Power: 60 watts (3.0 A @ 20.0 VDC)

Operating Temperature: 5° to 40°C (41° to 104° F)

WARNING:

Serious Shock Hazard. Do not open the DC Power Adapter. The fuse is the only serviceable part. Refer all other servicing to your home care professional or Respironics, Inc.

### FUSE REPLACEMENT


### BATTERY ADAPTER CABLE

- Step 1 Open the fuse holder by securing one end while turning the other end counter-clockwise.
- Step 2 Replace the fuse. See the table below for information on fuse types.
- Step 3 Close the fuse holder by securing one end and then turning the other end clockwise until the connection is tight.



### CIGARETTE LIGHTER ADAPTER

- Step 1 Open the fuse holder by turning the cap counter-clockwise and removing the fuse holder to expose the fuse.
- Step 2 Replace the fuse, being careful not to dislodge the spring inside the fuse holder. See the table below for information on fuse types.
- Step 3 Replace the tip of the fuse holder and cap. Turn the cap clockwise until the connection is tight.
